General Guidelines for Poster Presentation:

Authors have to follow the following guidelines for abstract submission.

- Abstracts must be submitted in English and must be presented in English.
- The body of abstract (must not be more than 300 words. If more, it would be truncated at 300 words.
- The work being presented should be original and should have not been published anywhere.
- Abstract for poster must be submitted online only.
- Submitted Poster shall be categorized as: Case report, Case series, Original article, Secondary data analysis.
- All the posters will be reviewed by the subject experts and the presenting authors have to be physically present at the time of poster evaluation.

Formatting/Submission Instructions:

- The title should be as informative as possible.
- Please provide 'First' and 'Last/Surname' of all authors as well as their Departments and Institution names.
- Body of the abstract must be structured in the following headings:- Background and Aim, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- Abstracts not conforming to the guidelines will not be considered for evaluation.
